

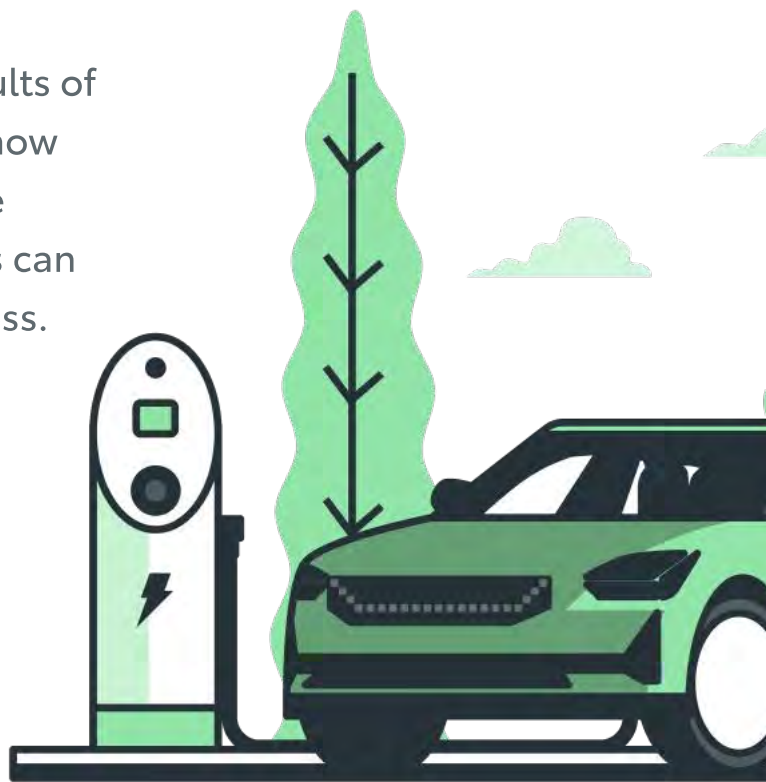

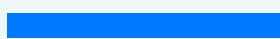
Meet EU Regulations

Starting in 2025, the European Union will require large and listed companies to disclose information related to their Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) practices, with a particular focus on the impact of their activities on people and the environment. The CSRD's technical rules known as the ESRS lay out what companies need to disclose and how. Disclosures on these topics will need to exist in annual reports alongside financials, and will also be subject to audit assurance.

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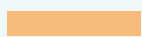
